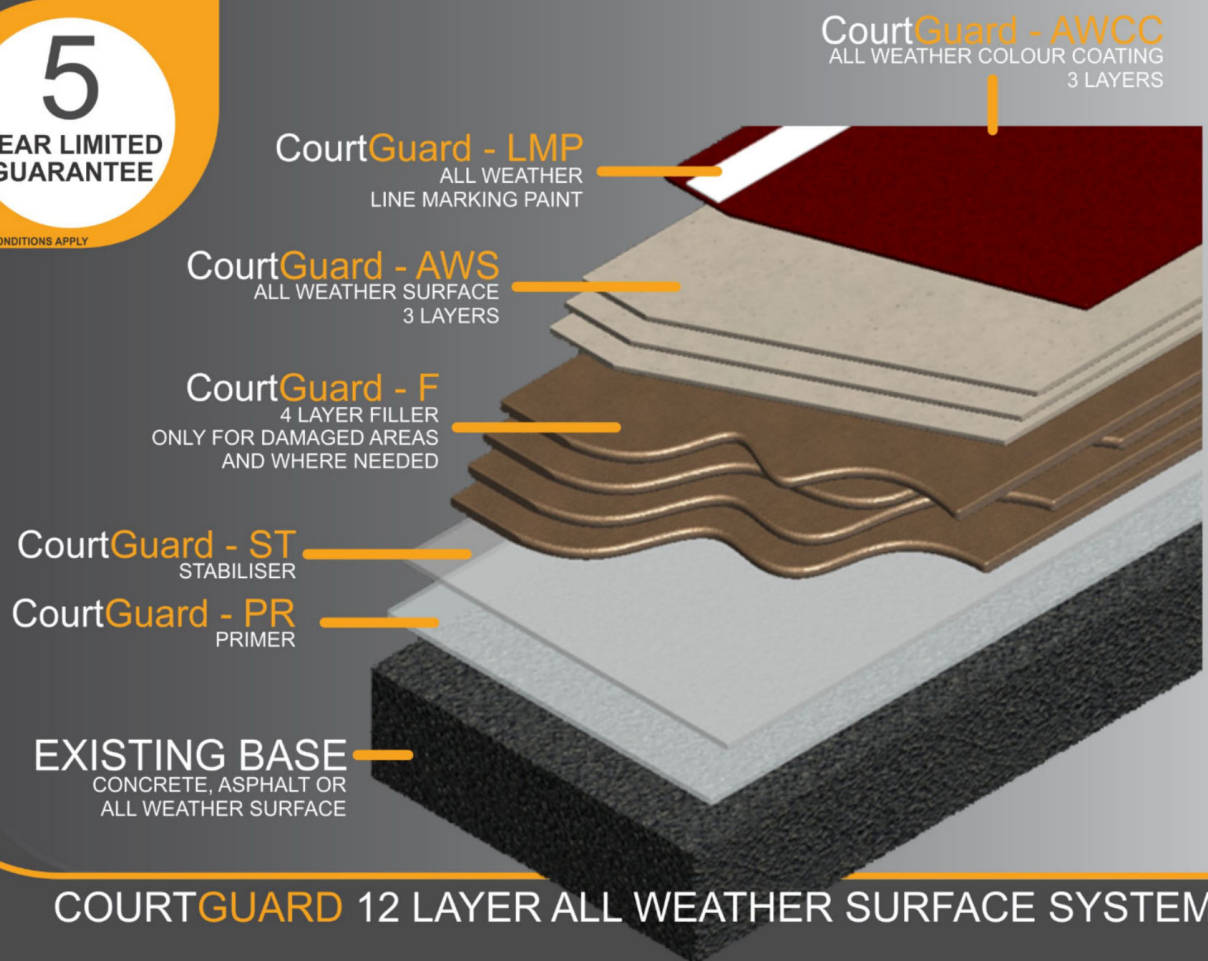

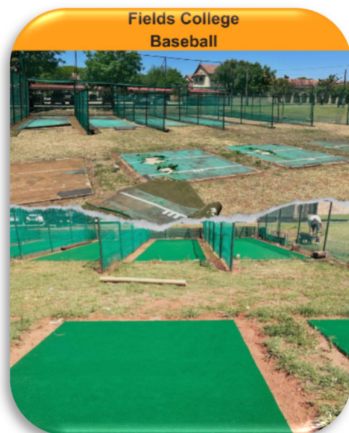

INTRODUCTION

Our product was formulated by one of the director's fathers more than 55 years ago and has been a class leading hardcourt all-weather surface system ever since. We have more than 16 years' experience in the South African hardcourt industry.

CourtGaurd carries a 5-year guarantee on the applied materials used, against Colour fading, delaminating from surface it's applied to and against lines fading.

When playing on our surface you will experience amazing grip and texture to ensure that you are able to take full advantage of your skills whether it is Netball, Tennis, Basketball or Handball.

We are a turnkey all-weather hardcourt resurface company, we can provide everything from earthworks to fencing, lighting where necessary or as little as installing CourtGaurd sleeves and posts for quick hassle-free switching of the various sport codes on multipurpose courts. All Work is done according in accordance with The OHS Guidelines and OSH safety file are available for each site (site specific files are charged for).

THE PROCESS

We use a 12 layer resurface process designed to strengthen and extend the life span of your court/s giving you a longer period (up to 10 years) between resurface cycles, dependent on the construction of the substructure and the resurfacing method used.

SCOPE OF WORK

- One set of lines painted per court (We use Plascon Polvin as this will not crack the court and gives 7 years use).
- All existing steel sports posts for each court (tennis, Netball and basketball) will be treated for rust and painted with either green or white enamel (custom colours can be used but will be quoted on dependent on colour).
- One standard size practice wall will be surfaced with CourtGaurd All-weather Surface, repainted and waterproofed (if needed) providing it has not been painted will an oil-based paint.
- All worksites are supervised/reviewed by the Project Manager and or a director on a daily basis.
- Daily updates via WhatsApp with a progress report of the courts, to keep clients fully appraised of the status. A weekly progress report is emailed to keep all parties up to date.
- All ground staff are instructed/trained on how to properly maintain the courts once the contracted work is complete.

WHAT MAKES US UNIQUE IN THIS INDUSTRY

- CourtGaurd resurfacing Materials were designed by an industrial chemist and we still consult the top specialists in the country to improve the product even more. As a result of this ongoing research and development our surface material is now mould resistant and 25% stronger than our closest competitor. Our Colour Coat paint is also mould resistant and 100% stronger than our closest competitor.
- Our entire Resurfacing system is based on Specialized Acrylic Polymers which is what gives it, it's strength. We use no Bitumen in the surfacing process as this cannot adhere to the Acrylic Polymers used and delaminates after a relatively short period of time. Which is what 99% of what resurfaces use.
- Our surface and Colour coats are mixed on-site mechanically with purpose made blades ensuring even dispersion of the raw materials, as opposed to the traditional hand mixing tools used (this is a Industry first)
- All our products are weighed out on an industrial scale on-site when mixing to ensure the highest level of quality and consistency with all our surfacing products applied (our staff are highly skilled at their work)
- Our lines are all triangulated to ensure high levels of accuracy and our circles are applied with a custom engineered radial arm for clean, tidy and accurate finishes.
- Our two site Forman have been in the industry more than 23 years, experience is the best teacher.

SAFETY, SECURITY AND COMPLIANCE

- We are fully compliant with Workman's Compensation and South African Revenue Service all Letters of compliance and certificates are available on request.
- We are fully insured for public liability.
- We comply with and uphold the Standards as laid out in the occupational health and safety act; we have a safety file onsite that is available upon request.
- Our Teams have trained first aiders level 1.
- ALL our staff have South African identity documents or passports with work permits and are here legally. (this is becoming a big problem in this industry undocumented workers)
- All staff get OHS Medicals done annually.
- All staff are security certified annually and have their identity documents on them while onsite.
- All staff wear High visibility uniforms that are Plasticourt branded and can be identified at a glance as working for Plasticourt.

CAUTION IS THE ELDEST CHILD OF WISDOM

We have found the need to warn our clients about certain application methods that cause long term damage that can in most cases cannot be resolved but rather have to be lived with after it has been done.

- A. Bitumen based surface materials cannot be applied to all-weather surface material as it is unable to bond with it and will begin to crumble and lift. Very similar to when you apply PVA to enamel it peels.
- B. Fiber mesh as a means to inhibit cracks, this is impossible! All structural faults will return unless the foundation is ripped up and rebuilt. In addition to it not working it causes most surfaces to bubble wrinkle and lift. It also over time cracks the foundation of your courts along the seam where it gets joined.
- C. Building courts in the chip and spray method. If done well its max life span is 5 years and, in most cases, less than that, they will always crack with subsurface movement and require more frequent maintenance by means of resurfacing to keep them playable. ALL COURTS SHOULD BE BUILT WITH HOT PREMIX ASPHALT AND A SUBSTRUCTURE OF G4 FILLER MATERIAL!
- D. You cannot build (overlay) a new court on top of an old broken court this will become a lattice of cracks and will need to be completely rebuilt in most cases.
- E. Finishing layer of all courts should be an all-weather paint not an all-weather surface Colour coat as it needs to be sealed to give it a longer life span.

MAINTENANCE OF COURTGUARD ALL WEATHER COURTS

- Poison weeds and ants.
- Dilute bird dropping (Uric acid) with warm water DO NOT SCRUB.
- Touch up areas damaged by bird dropping (Uric acid).
- Open channels to allow water flow off the courts.
- Sweep or roll standing water (defined as 24hrs in sunlight) off the courts with a soft broom or roller.
- Treat areas with excessive damp developing algae or mould with CourtGaurd Mold Combat.
- All courts must be blown / swept to clear any debris or sand from the court before play and out of season at least once a week.
- Newly surfaced courts may not be washed off with a hosepipe for 6 Months (never with a high-pressure hose). Thereafter not more than once a month though it should only be done if needed.
- Cut back all foliage from around the court All hardcourts love sunshine.
- Keep all irrigation systems aimed way from the court.
- Wherever possible keep all garden beds or soil below the level of the court or put a retaining wall and or storm water channel to keep soil and debris off the court.
- If you have a tennis net on your court keep it de tensioned when not in use to avoid damage to posts and tension cable.

We guarantee all materials applied by Plasticourt to your courts for 5 years from the date of completion against Colour fading, delaminating from the surface it's applied to and against lines fading. With Normal intended use and maintenance adhered to.

Not Covered

- Structural faults (cracks) returning
 - Only way to stop this from happening is to rip up and rebuild the entire foundation and playing surface.
- Water Standing on the court (ponding), we make every effort to reduce or eliminate water standing after rain, however this also requires a rebuild in most cases.
 - We recommend using our court roller, squeegee and platform broom as a preventative measure in the instances when ponding occurs.
- Malicious damage of any sort.
- Damage due to playing in wet weather or on wet or damp courts.

- Growth or regrowth of vegetation, not limited to but including weeds, grass and tree roots.
- Damage cause by Bird dropping as it contains uric acid and if not diluted it will eat away the surface and paint, we apply.
- We are not responsible for any surface applications below ours, done with inferior or incorrect materials delaminating.
- We are not responsible for foundations and structural integrity of courts we have not built from scratch.
- We are not responsible for the levels or the lie of the court if we did not build it, though will make every reasonable effort to improve the levels where possible through our multi directional resurfacing system.
- Any damage caused by any foreign materials applied to the surface.
- Any damage caused by use of high-pressure water cleaners.
- Any damage from high impact loading.
- Any damage from using incorrect footwear or equipment.

PLASTICOURT MAINTENANCE PLAN

Plasticourt offers a maintenance plan that runs **weekly or bi-weekly** to help lengthen the lifespan of your courts. We have found that courts that need to be redone prematurely due to any of the following factors:

- Grass growing in and around the edges and damaging the base and the surface.
- Tree roots growing in from the edges and cracking the base and creating “speed Bumps” on the courts.
- Mushrooms growing under the courts and bursting through the surface.
- Ants burrowing under the courts and making holes and dirt stains.
- Water standing for extended periods and creating black algae and or dirt stains sometimes to the point of rotting the surface.
- Bird Droppings eating away at the surface because of the acid present in it.

WHAT WE OFFER

- Poison grass and vegetation growing on the edge of the court before the damage occurs, where damage has occurred repair before it gets worse and apply all-weather surface material to damaged area (if tar is needed to repair this will be quoted separately).
- Monitor the edges of the court to make sure that tree roots are not encroaching, cut off roots and inhibit further growth of that root with copper where possible (if major trenching or removal and reinstating of paving is required this will be quoted separately).
- Poison mushrooms, then remove and (if tar is needed to repair this will be quoted separately).
- Poison ants and close hole with all-weather surface (where the problem is prolific we will recommend pest specialists).
- Where there is standing water, we will clean off black algae with “CourtGaurd mold away” and open up channels to allow water to flow off more freely (where possible).
- Clean off bird droppings and touch up with all-weather surface as needed.
- Ensure all dual post holes are free from debris and painted with rust converter on the bottom of the posts if needed (repairs to posts can be done at our engineering workshop Amalgadyne and will be quoted on a case-by-case basis).
- A full report given on the condition of the court, actions taken and recommendations for any actions needed by the school.
